The Human Resources Management Authority regularly considers the Working team Reports to follow the construction/ reconstruction of the ReSPA premises.

According to the submitted Reports, works on the building site consist of three parts:

- First part relates to the reconstruction of the current building where the ReSPA Secretariat will be seated, as well as the space for training located - all the structural renovation works are finished. At this moment, according to the determined schedule, works on the interior and installation have been implemented. This includes electricity works, heating/cooling systems, plumbing, sewage, etc.
- Second part refers to constructing of the accommodation building - all the structural renovation works are finished e.g. the object is walled to the last floor, including the roof board. Currently the works on the internal division of rooms and formation of the internal space, as well as the works on the plumbing installation and electricity are being implemented.
- Third part refers to the site organisation - it is in its early phase; the contractor has just started cleaning the site and formed the routes for the internal roads and parking.

The realisation of this part of the works depends on the delivery of necessary documentation from the local utility enterprises dealing with plumbing, sewage and electrical infrastructure.

Visit of the national expert of EIPA(European Institution of Public Administration) to the Human Resources Management Authority
