Mr. Metodija Dimovski was born 16 July 1966 in Skopje, the capital of the Republic of Macedonia. He is married and has two children.

His education includes secondary school in Economy (1981-1984), university diploma in Geography (1985-1989), and Master of Science in Geography (1990-1994). His mother tongue is Macedonian and he is fluent in English and Serbian/Croatian, and uses French as well. He is having high level of computer literacy.
